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Change para 7-1a to read: TRADOC conducts annual series of four reviews to provide a warfighting focus to the Army's S&T investment: The S&T review, the Joint User/Developer STO review, the ATD review and the Special Access Program (SAP) Review.

Add to 7-1 para e. In the (SAP) Review, TRADOC reviews and assesses acquisition SAP's to determine their relevance to the CBTDEV FOCs, technical merit and establish a relative priority of each SAP program.

Add Para 7-8. Special Access Program (SAP) Review. In April, TRADOC hosts the Special Access Program (SAP) review for Special Access Program Oversight Committee (SAPOC) Council of Colonels (COC). Existing SAP programs and prospective SAP's are reviewed. To provide for continuity between the S&T reviews, the same COC at HQ TRADOC conducts both reviews and the timing is synchronized to permit comparison and application of the same measures of merit. The COC consists of directors from each hardware directorate in DCSCD, BLITCD and representatives from AMC and HQDA.

a. CBTDEV's will--

(1) Conduct a review of each SAP assessing the warfighting relevance to FOCs/AUTLs.

(2) Assign a score to each SAP that supports one or more of their FOCs/AUTLs.

b. Program Managers will provide program briefings to the SAPOC to include how their program is supporting applicable FOCs/AUTLs and the Army's future vision validated by their customer/proponent.

c. TRADOC COC will--


(1) Validate CBTDEV's assessment of FOCs and score.

(2) Compare special access technology with STO technology for overlap and rank them with STO's.

(3) Generate a prioritized list of SAPs.

d. DCSCD approves prioritized list of SAPs and provides to the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Acquisition, Logistics and Technology), Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Operations and Plans (Force Development), appropriate Program Executive Offices and US Army Materiel Command.
