SUBJECT: CES Advanced and Intermediate Course Credit for SBLM Class 06-1

1. Request Civilian Education System (CES) Advanced and Intermediate Course credit be granted for the students attending the Sustaining Base Leadership and Management (SBLM) Resident Class 06-1. A significant number of the CES Advanced and Intermediate Course critical tasks are fully covered in the SBLM Class 06-1 curriculum. Therefore awarding credit to these students is warranted.

2. The Army Management Staff College (AMSC) is currently teaching a substantial number of CES Advanced and Intermediate Course critical tasks to SBLM students. Eighty-Five (85%) of the CES Advanced Course critical tasks (Enclosure 1) and Eighty-Eight (88%) of the CES Intermediate Course critical tasks (Enclosure 2) have been fully integrated into SBLM Resident Class 06-1. The analysis substantiating this is contained in the CES Advanced Course Task Integration Analysis (Enclosure 3) and the CE's Intermediate Course Task Integration Analysis (Enclosure 4). The only tasks from the CES Advanced and Intermediate Course critical task lists not completely integrated into SBLM at this time are highlighted in Enclosure 1 and Enclosure 2.
