1. 2. Referenced memorandum delegates Civilian Human Resources (CHR) Authorities and comprises the most current version of the CHR authorities delegations. The referenced memorandum reaffirms and reissues CHR authorities 1-37 and rescinds all previous versions of the CHR authority delegations. CHR Authorities 2, 6, 15, 17, 23, 26, 27, and 30, listed on the matrix, have not been delegated to this command. The remaining 29 authorities have been delegated to me with authority to further delegate as specified in the referenced memorandum.
3. By this memorandum, I delegate CHR authorities 1, 3, 4, 5, and 7 through 13, 14, 16, 18 through 22, 24, 25, 28, 29, and 31 through 37, as authorized in Matrix Version 06-2014, 16 December 2014, to the following:


SUBJECT: Delegation of Civilian Human Resources Authorities, Version 06-2014, effective December 16, 2014: Revision to Delegation of Civilian Human Resources Authorities Matrix and Execution, Publication and Transmission of Delegations #1 thru 37

I. Deputy Chiefs of General and Chiefs of Special Staff Offices, HQ TRADOC.

4. In appropriate, authorized cases, designated CHR authorities may be further delegated to TRADOC personnel in writing no lower than O-6 or GS-15. Particular attention should be paid to the matrix' "special instructions" to ensure any subsequent delegation issued is authorized. In all cases, any TRADOC official with authority to further delegate should consider the financial responsibilities and processes within your command.

5. Designated delegations are effective immediately and expire as stated in the accompanying matrix, unless earlier suspended, revoked, or superseded. The referenced memorandum and its accompanying matrix are not a complete compilation of delegated Army personnel authorities. Consult your activity's human resources specialist regarding any other existing CHR authorities that may have been delegated below HQ TRADOC level and which may not be specified in this memorandum.

6. Local labor relations obligations should be met upon receipt of this delegation memorandum.
