SUBJECT: TRADOC Regulation 672-6, Military Coins

1. **Purpose:** To describe the policies and procedures for the purchase and award of military coins within TRADOC.

2. **Discussion Points:**

- Authority. Commanders of TRADOC organizations regularly commanded by a field grade officer, and commandants of noncommissioned officer academies are authorized to use appropriated funds to purchase military coins.
- Limitations. Authorized commanders may not purchase more than \$5000 worth of military coins in a single fiscal year without HQ, TRADOC Chief of Staff approval.
- Criteria for Award. Coins are given to recognize excellence, unique accomplishment, or to further recruitment of personnel. Coins may also be presented to non-DA personnel as honorary awards for services that significantly support the Army. Coins are never given away as mementos.
- Record Keeping. All purchases of military coins must be tracked and reported through the chain of command each fiscal year. Installation commanders and school commandants must consolidate these reports and forward electronically to the Deputy Chief of Staff for Resource Management, HQ TRADOC, atrmb@monroe.army.mil no later than 1 November for the preceding fiscal year.
